Persons detained still need to be in touch with their families and to purchase personal care items (toothpaste, toilet paper, etc.) that family members are not permitted to provide for them. Money received will be placed in their accounts at the detention centers, as it is needed.

Remaining funds will be used to offset attorney fees for costs associated with their pro bono work and also for long-term needs. Long-term needs may include providing financial assistance to families to travel to work, for rent and/or utilities. Assistance will be coordinated with the St. Vincent de Paul Society and other organizations.

Donated goods, including diapers, wipes, baby formula, and food, are being collected during parish office hours, Monday through Friday, at the St. Joan of Arc Building (tan building behind Domino's Pizza, accessible from the church parking lot).

If you would like to make a monetary donation, checks may be made payable to St. Paul Catholic Church, with "Immigration Outreach" on the memo line. Checks may be dropped off at the Parish Office or placed in the collection basket.
